Admission requirements

- To be considered for the MBA you need to meet the requirements listed below: Honours Degree in a relevant field (NQF Level 8) with an overall average of 60% OR
- A PGDip in Management, PGDip in Business Management, PGDip in Business Administration or related NQF Level 8 qualifications with an overall average of 60%
- OR
- A cognate Bachelor's Degree equivalent at NQF level 8 AND
- Proof of English language proficiency (for students who have not studied at the tertiary level in English)
- A minimum of 4 years of work experience at an appropriate level (a minimum of two years of managerial experience)
- Applicants may be asked to do a JBS Admission Test (Psychometric Tests)

Admission requirements for international students:

• Applicants who hold a foreign qualification need to send their qualifications to the South African Qualifications Authority (SAQA) for evaluation before applying to JBS. We require the SAQA certificate to verify the NQF level of your qualification.
